

Setup Exchange Rate

Firstly you need to setup an exchange rate.

You do this by adding an exchange rate setup button onto your screen.

When you click on this button it pops up the below screen



Name: Name of Currency Rate: Exchange Rate Symbol: Currency Symbol

You need to tick the alternative Currency Box.

Setup Foreign Payment

You now need to add a button on your main screen for staff to be able to take payment in this foreign currency.

The keyboard function for this is

FOREIGN PAYMENT



Now when you make a sale on the bottom of the sale window you will have the transaction total in both currencies.

To cash off the sale in main currency use the normal payment system.

To cash out in the alternative currency press the foreign payment button you added.



This allows you to give change in either local or foreign currency.

You can also have multiple currencies and choose from the drop down to select what currency you require.
